You will be responsible for the **implementation of the Jobnet Employment Program for clients in a designated region under the guidance of a Jobnet Coordinator**. The aim of the program is to support clients to find open employment by focusing on their strengths and interests and improving their vocational and community independence skills.

The successful applicant will be rewarded with a **remuneration package of \$36,276 - \$38,278 plus 9% super**. In addition you will also receive **salary sacrifice options** to significantly increase your take home pay (by reducing the amount of tax you pay), a **mobile phone allowance** and **access to a vehicle for work-related travel**.
