The organisation is now seeking Multicultural Family Workers to join the team, being at the forefront of all communications while organising events which will support disadvantaged and marginalised families.

This position entails working with a varied and dynamic team while building external partnerships. Within these varied and dynamic roles, you will be required to perform in all areas including representing the organising at conferences, seminars and networking meetings, interacting with diverse community groups, planning and delivering workshops and family days, maintaining database records, case management and reporting to relevant bodies.

Community Youth Worker (Part time Position 1 year contract)

Also required is a Community Youth Worker to work with young people, their families and communities. You will need to understand the issues surrounding youth disconnecting from families, community and vocational activities. The successful applicant will be required to provide programs and activities promoting self esteem and skill development with a view of rebuilding family relationships.
